Sa ilalim ng dating gobyerno ng Labour, paulit-ulit na mali ang pagkakatawan ng mga katotohanan tungkol sa National Broadband Network sa publiko ng Australia – na ikinapula nina Stephen Conroy at Anthony Albanese nang mahayag ang kanilang mga maling pahayag sa publiko tungkol sa mga gastos at ang rollout pagkatapos ng halalan noong Setyembre 2013.

Nakalulungkot, walang natutunan si Jason Clare at walang nakalimutan. Ang kanyang pinakahuling mga pahayag tungkol sa NBN ay nire-recycle ang pamilyar na mga taktika ng pagbalukot at panlililang.

Sinabi ni Mr Clare na "ang pangalawang Badyet ng Abbott Government ay patunay na ang NBN ay mas mabagal kaysa sa ipinangako ni Malcolm Turnbull." Bilang ebidensya ay binanggit niya ang kalahating bilyong dolyar ng equity funding para sa NBN Co na sa Badyet ay itinulak pabalik mula sa 2013-14 at 2014-15 na mga taon ng pananalapi patungo sa mga susunod na taon.

Ang mga katotohanan tungkol sa NBN ay hindi mapag-aalinlangan.

- Katotohanan: Noong Hunyo 2013 ang paglulunsad ng NBN ay umabot lamang sa 17 porsiyento ng target na inihayag ng Labor noong Disyembre 2010.
- Katotohanan: Noong Setyembre 2013, pagkatapos ng anim na taon ng gobyerno ng Labor at \$6.5 bilyon na pamumuhunan, 2 porsiyento ng mga lugar sa Australia ay maaaring ma-access ang NBN. Ang iba pang 98 porsiyento ay nakakuha ng kaunti o wala mula sa anim na taon ng patakaran sa Paggawa.
- Katotohanan: Noong Setyembre 2013, inaangkin na 284,200 bahay at negosyo ang maaaring makakuha ng broadband o mga serbisyo ng telepono sa NBN. Ngunit 104,200 ay walang fiber 'drop' mula sa kalye patungo sa lugar, at nahaharap sa paghihintay ng anim na buwan o higit pa kung sila ay nag-utos ng serbisyo. ^[1] (https://www-malcolmturnbull-com-au.translate.goog/media/labor-misleads-on-the-nbn?_x_tr_sl=en&x_tr_tl=ar&x_tr_hl=en&x_tr_pto=wapp#_ftn1)
- Katotohanan: Mula noong Setyembre 2013 ang bilang ng mga Australyano na maaaring kumonekta sa NBN ay tumaas ng apat na beses; mayroong 918,000 na magagamit na lugar sa fixed line at fixed wireless footprint noong Mayo 7, 2015.
- Katotohanan: Sa parehong panahon, ang mga lugar na may serbisyo sa NBN ay tumaas mula 90,500 noong Setyembre 2013 hanggang 420,959 noong Mayo 7.
- Katotohanan: Ang Disyembre 2013 NBN Co Strategic Review at 2014-2017 NBN Co Corporate Plan ay nagtakda ng target na 1.1 milyong lugar na naipasa noong Hunyo 30, 2015. Nasa tamang landas ang NBN Co upang makamit ang target na ito, tulad ng pag-abot nito sa target na paglulunsad noong Hunyo 2014. Ito ang magiging dalawang taunang target na rollout sa kasaysayan ng NBN Co hanggang sa kasalukuyan na nakamit.
- Katotohanan: Ang takbo ng NBN na 10 linggong rolling run rate ay bumilis sa 8,200 na lugar kada linggo sa brownfield (itinatag) na mga lugar. Iyan ay tumaas mula sa isang average na 2,500 bawat linggo sa 2012-13 na taon ng pananalapi - ang huling buong taon sa ilalim ng Paggawa - at isang average na 4,100 na lugar ng brownfield bawat linggo sa 2013-14 na taon ng pananalapi.
- Katotohanan: Sa halip na nagkakahalaga ng \$2500 bawat premise gaya ng inaangkin sa 2012-2015 NBN Corporate Plan na inaprubahan ng Labor, o ang \$2200 na inaangkin ng dating pamamahala ng NBN Co bilang ebidensya sa isang Parliamentary Committee, ang mga gastos sa bawat premise para sa NBN fiber sa paglulunsad ng lugar ay may average na \$4300. ^[2] (https://www-malcolmturnbull-com-au.translate.goog/media/labor-misleads-on-the-nbn?_x_tr_sl=en&x_tr_tl=ar&x_tr_hl=en&x_tr_pto=wapp#_ftn2)

Tulad ng makikita, ang mga pahayag ni Mr Clare ng isang mas mabagal kaysa sa binalak na paglulunsad sa ilalim ng Koalisyon na ipinahayag ng mga pagtataya ng Badyet ng equity investment ay purong kathang-isip. Ang mga target ay natugunan gamit ang mas kaunting kapital kaysa sa orihinal na hula.

Gumagawa si Mr Clare ng ilang iba pang mga claim.

- Sinabi niya na ang paglulunsad ng multi-technology mix na NBN ay hindi pa nagsisimula. Binabalewala nito ang pag-deploy ng fiber-to-the-node na pagsubok na pinagsama-samang isinagawa ng NBN Co at Telstra sa nakalipas na apat na buwan, na umaabot sa mga lugar kabilang ang 250,000 lugar, at ang kamakailang inanunsyo na paparating na mga pagsubok ng HFC. Ang FTTN joint trial ay lumampas sa bilang ng mga tunay na mapaglilingkuran na lugar sa buong NBN na iniwan ng Labor.
- Tumpak na sinabi ni Mr Clare na ang patakaran ng Coalition ay orihinal na inilaang "malaking sukat na paglulunsad ng anumang mga pagbabago sa disenyo ng network - tulad ng pagpapatupad ng fiber sa node - ay magsisimula sa kalagitnaan ng 2014." Habang ang mga pagsubok ng FTTN ay nai-deploy, totoo na ang komersyal na pagpapalabas ng FTTN ay naantala, bagaman ang komersyal na pagpapalabas ng Fiber to the Basement (FTTB) ay nagsimula noong Marso 2015.

Ang isang pangunahing hadlang ay ang pagsisimula sa ibang pagkakataon para sa mga pag-amyenda na napagkasunduan sa NBN Co/Telstra definitive agreements (DAs), na hindi inaasahang magkakaroon ng walang kondisyong epekto hanggang sa kalagitnaan ng 2015. Siyempre, ang Labor ay maaaring, at dapat, nakipag-usap sa pag-access sa umiiral na imprastruktura ng tanso at HFC na kailangan para sa paglulunsad ng MTM noong unang napag-usapan ang mga DA – ngunit mabibigat na nabigo na protektahan ang mga interes ng mga nagbabayad ng buwis sa pamamagitan ng hindi paggawa nito.

Ang pangalawang pangunahing hadlang ay ang estado ng mga IT system sa NBN Co, na kulang sa maraming lugar noong umalis ang dating pamamahala at Lupon ng NBN Co sa kumpanya. Isa lamang ito sa maraming pangunahing kahinaan sa NBN Co, na hindi kapani-paniwalang kasama rin ang kawalan ng katanggap-tanggap na mga account sa gastos sa pananalapi at batay sa aktibidad - ang kinahinatnan nito ay na sa ilalim ng

Malcom is a pushing lies to the public about performance of VDSL for FTTN connections. The speeds he applauds on his own website that were attained in trial areas of FTTN are far higher than those attained in equivalent connections rolled out as standard in the same areas as the test cases. NBN states that a speed of 40-60MB/s on a 100MB connection is sufficient and warrants no further investigation. "It's not fast but at least you've got a connection" - simply not an adequate attitude NBNco. So clearly - either the trial connections were highly tweaked to obtain optimum results (and such 'tweaks' will not be applied for normal users) or Malcom's numbers are simply a fabrication to quell the dissatisfaction of the public at the LNP's very poorly performing alternative to FTTP that's costing just as much if not more. Why roll out copper in areas where the existing copper is cactus instead of replacing with fibre - it's simply ludicrous.
